Grab and Go Lunches

1. These sites are sponsored by Poudre School Nutrition Department and are distributed Monday – Friday from **Noon until 1pm**. Due to the Stay at Home orders children are no longer required to be present to receive a lunch. Parent/Guardian can request the number of lunches needed. Breakfast for the next morning is also included in these lunches or as a separate bag depending on location. Ask when you arrive. Drive through only – no walk ups.
