January tidbits!

Parent Teacher conferences are coming up! You will receive a note from your teacher when we return from break. Your teacher may request a conference, and you have the option to request a conference. Please watch for this note and send it back to school. Conferences will be January 18th and 20th from 3:45-6:45. Teachers may have other options available.

January also brings ACCESS tests for our student whose first language is not English. We are working on spring testing schedules for all students and will communicate that information soon.

If you chose to vaccinate (COVID) your child, we would appreciate having a copy on file. If your child is identified as a close contact at school, BUT we have the vaccination on file, your child will not receive quarantine orders

We are outside if the temperature is 10 degrees or above with the wind chill factor. We will eat outside if it is 40 degrees or above. Inside lunch is the time that kids are most likely identified as close contacts.

Lunch inside is spaced as much as we possibly can. To do this, we are using the lunch room and gym for inside lunch. Both areas are cleaned between each group and utilize seating charts as required. When your child is in the gym, we sit on tarps so they are easy to clean and Mr. Janicki can use his space right after lunch. Students have the option to sit in a chair if they prefer that over the floor. We will "switch sides" every 3 weeks or so.

<u>I Matter</u> - Youth are eligible for three free therapy sessions

Colorado youth and their parents can visit the <u>I Matter platform</u> to take a confidential online survey about their mental health and schedule sessions with a licensed behavioral health clinician, primarily online over telehealth. State law allows youth ages 12 and up to use the platform independently; youth ages 11 and younger will need their parent or guardian's consent to sign up. Learn more on the <u>I Matter website</u>.

School News

- If you have moved outside of our boundary area and would like your child to continue attending Linton for the 2022-2023 school year you need to complete a School of Choice application. The School of Choice application is available online at: https://www.psdschools.org/schools/school-options-choice The deadline to apply for School of Choice is Friday, January 21st at 12:00 PM.
- We are already looking ahead to new kindergarten students who will be enrolling for the 2022-2023 school year. Students who are 5 years old on or before October 1st are eligible for kindergarten. We will have computers available at Linton for registration on Thursday, January 20th from 7:30 AM 4:30 PM. If you have access to a computer at home, you do not need to come in on the 20th. Kindergarten orientation is January 10th from 5:30-6:30 PM-this is an informational meeting for PARENTS ONLY.
- When you are registering your student, you will need to upload their birth certificate, immunization records and proof of residency such as a lease agreement or utility bill. You may also drop those off in person at the front office.
- Please share kindergarten registration information with any friends, neighbors or family members who may have a child ready for kindergarten.
- 5th Grade families Boltz Middle School will be hosting an Open House on Wednesday, January 12th from 5:30 PM 7:00 PM. You will have an opportunity to tour the school, meet with teachers and staff as well as learn about the programs offered at Boltz Middle School.
- Boltz Middle School counselors will be at Linton on Friday, February 4th to share schedule information with our 5th grade students. Students will bring their packet home to share with parents before submitting them to Boltz Middle School.

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
















STEM-X presents:

- Engineering Brightness- students in grades 6-9 @ Preston MS; In this workshop students and their attending adult, will design a safe, hand held, 3D printed, sustainable lantern. Mechanical and electrical engineering skills are not only learned, but applied, and refined using the design thinking model.
- Birds, Bees, and Butterflies: Designing a Pollinator and Bird Habitat in Your Yard- students in grade 6-8 @ Fossil Ridge HS; Students and their parents will work together to reimagine their yard and design a pollinator garden. They will learn the importance of creating pollinator/bird habitat, how to create it, and use the design process to develop concepts and a final design to take home and install.
- This is Rocket Science!- students in grade 6-8 @ Fossil Ridge HS; Are you interested in becoming a Rocket Scientist? Would you like to work for NASA, United Launch Alliance (ULA), Scaled Composites, Sierra Nevada, or SpaceX? Do you just love building really, really fast things? This workshop is for you! Come learn how to build and launch your own rocket.
- Introductory MiG Welding & Metalworking- students in grades 6-8 @ Fossil Ridge HS; Learn to weld using the GMAW (MIG) wirefeed welding process! We will cover specific safety for welding, appropriate personal protective equipment, and the proper technique for applying the MIG welding process. Please come dressed to work: workpants, cotton or wool-blend shirt, and work shoes or boots. Everything else will be provided. Participants will get to build a small metal project. Several choices will be provided!


