- Celebration of Learning

 - School competition (3rd,4th, and 5th grades)
 - Once school competition is complete it will go to the District level.
- Bell Schedules
 - Not changing next school year
- 5th Grade Legacy Project
 - Group of 5th grade students and Mrs. Stolte will come up with ideas and vote on a project.
 - More details coming soon!
- Small School Adjustments and Staffing for 2025/2026 School Year
 - Waiting for district to approve staffing and school budget for next year but this is the direction things should be moving...
 - Budget will be \$28,000-\$30,000 less
 - Title 1 funding cut by \$160,000
 - Small school money from Mill Levy should help offset the loss in funding
 - Maintaining 80% specials (important priority for staff)
 - Keeping classified staff
 - Moving to one section for 3rd grade (current 2nd grade class)
 - Will have a full time para
 - This grade level would be closed to school of choice
 - More communication to come as these plans are finalized

District Advisory Board Report

- Bell Schedules
 - Voted to keep current bell schedule for this school year
 - Will continue research
 - District doesn't have the money to hire more drivers and have struggled to get busses that they need
- Data for Charter Schools
 - The district will no longer give data (names, DOB, addresses) to charter schools for them to advertise to families
- Updates to Dyslexia program
 - Staff is now encouraged to use the dyslexia (they weren't previously)
 - There is a team that is working on support for staff and students
 - Working to identify older (middle and high school) students that weren't identified previously.
- 9th and 10th Grade New literacy program
 - Currently in the pilot phase

- Will offer flexible reading
 - One book for all 9th and 10th in the district
 - One book for all 9th and 10th in each school
 - Other books will be more flexible for students to pick and chose things that they are interested in

Treasurer Report

- Current budget in line
 - Checks paid to school for swamp cooler (reimbursement) and DJ Baxter from the Family Dance
 - Reviewed and made changes for proposed budget for 2025/2026 school year
 - Will review and have the first vote at the April meeting. Final vote at May meeting
