



NEED SCHOOL VACCINES? WE CAN HELP.

Community Clinics for children and families who qualify.

The Larimer County Department of Health & Environment is offering **low- or no-cost vaccines** to **children (ages 4 and older) and their families** who are uninsured, underinsured, or enrolled in most Medicaid plans. Vaccine clinics will be held at schools across the community to provide the following while supplies last:

- **Children:** All school-required vaccines
- **Adults:** MMR vaccine which protects against measles
- **All eligible participants:** Flu and COVID-19 vaccines based on availability.

Please Note:

- **Not eligible:** Private insurance and CHP+ are **not accepted** at these clinics.
- **What to bring:** Previous vaccine records and any school-issued vaccine letters.
